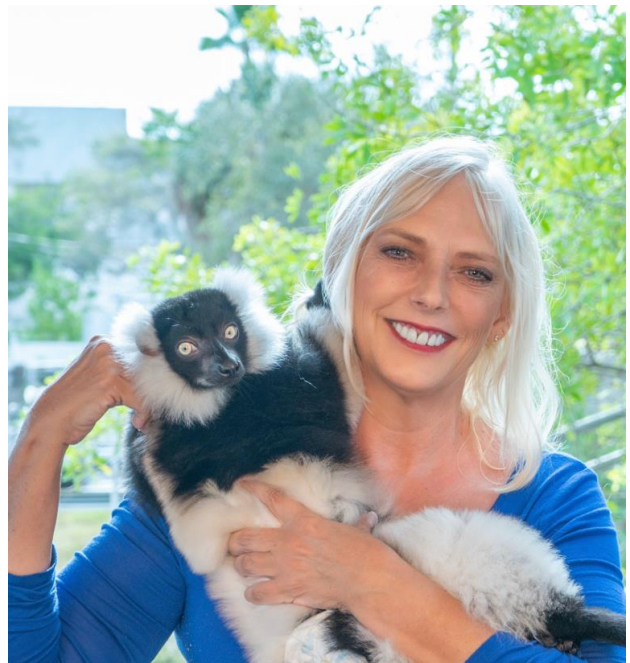

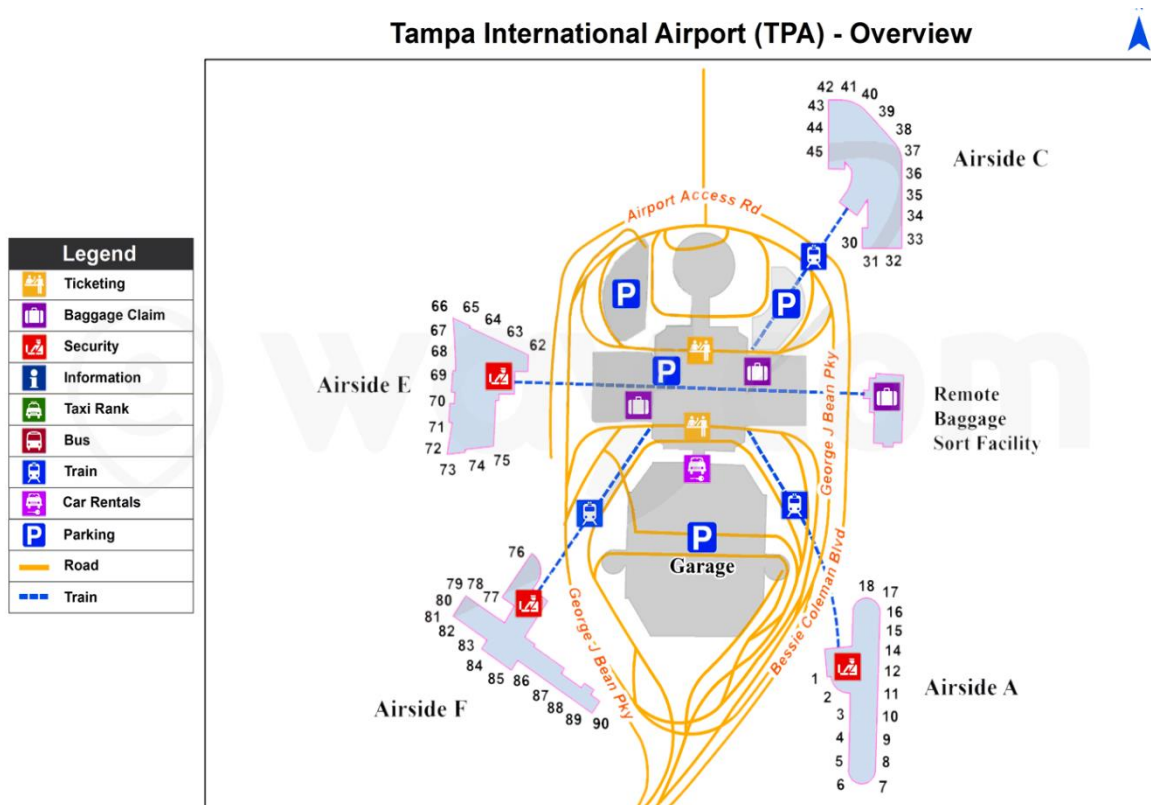
Arriving at TPA



Tampa International Airport (TPA) is the major airport located in Tampa, Florida, serving as a hub for both domestic and international flights. Upon arriving at TPA, passengers can expect a modern and efficient airport experience, with clear signage, well-organized terminals, and various amenities to ensure a smooth journey.

TPA is divided into four main terminals: A, C, E, and F, which serve different airlines. Depending on the airline you flew with, you will arrive at a specific terminal. The airport offers multiple services for passengers, including transportation options like taxis, ride-sharing services (Uber, Lyft), rental cars, and public transportation.

Tampa International Airport (TPA) - Overview

- American Airlines (terminal A)
- Delta Airlines (terminal C)

There are no Priority Pass lounges at TPA.

Canadian/Mexican Guests

For Canadian and Mexican visitors arriving at TPA, the process from getting off the plane to baggage claim involves a few steps. Here's an overview of the typical process:

1. Disembarkation

After your flight lands, you will exit the plane and follow signs leading to U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP). The walk to immigration will depend on your arrival gate.

2. U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP)

Upon arrival at TPA, all international travelers, including Canadian and Mexican visitors, must go through U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP). Here, you will present your passport, answer basic questions regarding your trip (purpose of visit, how long you'll stay, etc.), and have your photo and fingerprints taken.

3. Automated Passport Control (APC)

Many Canadian and Mexican travelers can use the Automated Passport Control kiosks, which can speed up the process. You'll scan your passport, answer a few questions on the screen, and receive a receipt. You may then proceed to the CBP officer to complete the process.

4. CBP Inspection

After using the kiosk, you will meet with a CBP officer, who may ask additional questions. The officer will stamp your passport and allow you entry into the U.S. This is a required step for all international arrivals.

5. International Baggage Claim

After clearing customs, you'll proceed to the baggage claim area. TPA has clearly marked signs guiding you to the correct carousel for your flight's baggage. Keep your baggage claim ticket handy, as it may be checked before you pick up your luggage.

6. Customs Inspection

Once you have your bags, you may be subject to a random customs inspection. If this happens, an officer will ask about the contents of your luggage. If everything is in order, you can proceed to the exit.

7. Exit and Ground Transportation

After collecting your baggage (if applicable), you'll exit through the Customs and Border Control area. Once you're in the main terminal, you can find ground transportation options, such as taxis, ride-share services (Uber, Lyft), or rental car services, to continue your journey.

8. Important Notes:

- a. **ESTA: Canadian and Mexican citizens do not need an ESTA (Electronic System for Travel Authorization) to travel to the United States.** Since both countries are part of the Visa Waiver Program (VWP), Canadian and Mexican citizens are generally allowed to enter the U.S. without a visa for short visits (tourism, business, or transit) of up to six months. However, you will still need a valid passport to enter the U.S. Always make sure to check the specific entry requirements for your situation before traveling.
- b. **Travel Documents: Ensure you have your valid passport with you,** as this is required for entry into the U.S.

This process is generally efficient, though it can take some time depending on the volume of travelers at the airport. Always allow plenty of time to go through these steps.

Baggage Claim

Baggage Claim is on Level 1 of the Main Terminal and is divided into Red on the north side and Blue on the south side. Signage above escalators and elevators will tell you on which side your airline is located.

Ground Transportation at TPA

There are a variety of ground transportation options between Tampa International Airport and the Sheraton Sand Key.

Red Baggage Claim: Pick up all ground transportation at the exit nearest to Baggage Belt #9

Blue Baggage Claim: Pick up all ground transportation at the exit nearest to Baggage Belt #7

Ride Share

Guests departing the Airport using Lyft, Uber or Wridz can be picked up at Red Baggage Claim, the Blue Express Curbside, or the SkyCenter One office building remote curbside. The approximate ride-

share fare from Tampa International Airport to the Sheraton Sand Key Resort in Clearwater Beach typically ranges from **\$35 to \$45** one way.

Taxis

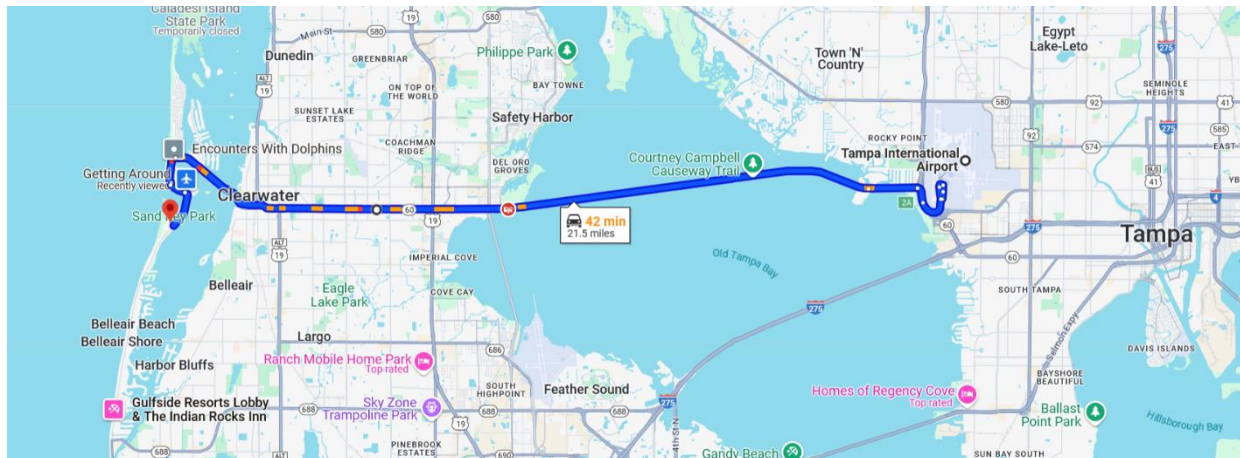
Taxi service by Yellow Cab is available at the curbside outside the Baggage Claim Level at the Ground Transportation Areas, Red 1 and Blue 2. The fares are: \$3.50 for the first 1/5 of a mile or part thereof, plus \$2.50 per mile. The minimum fee from the airport is \$20 and the approximate fare is around **\$40 to \$50** one way.

Rental Cars

On-airport rental car companies are located in the Rental Car Center which can be reached by taking the SkyConnect train from the Main Terminal. The SkyConnect train service is accessible from Levels 1 through 3 of the Main Terminal. Follows signs for Rental Cars, Public Bus, or SkyConnect.

Way2Go Rides

Private airport shuttles for \$79.50 for up to 6 people. Book in advance online at way2gorides.com (recommended) or call 727-424-5458. Save \$10 per ride when booking with code **SKAL**.



Sheraton Sand Key Resort is a **22-mile drive from TPA** (depending on time of day/traffic) and takes about **35 - 50 minutes**.

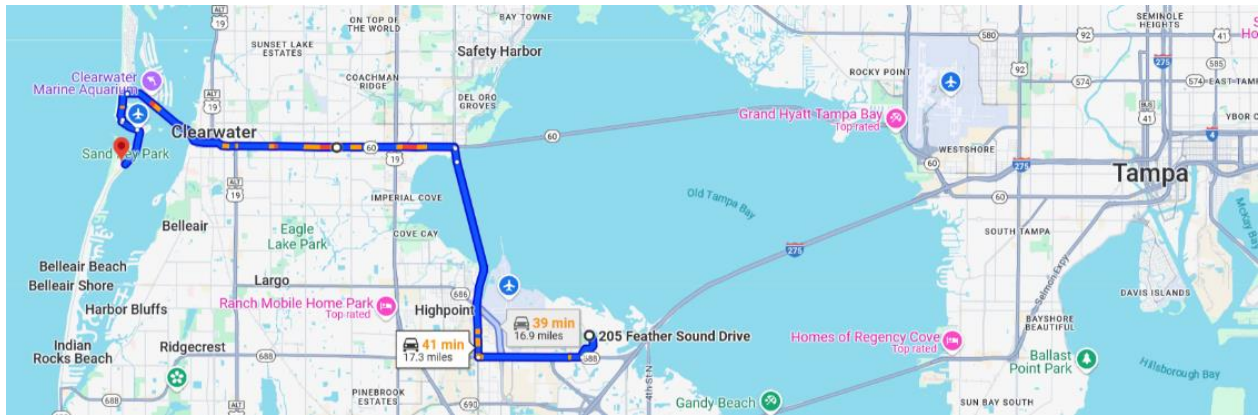
Arriving at PIE

St. Pete-Clearwater International Airport (PIE) primarily serves as a base for Allegiant Air, which is the main airline offering flights to and from the airport. There are no airline clubs at this airport.

The **Grouper Airport Express** is the most cost-effective service that provides rides between the airport and the Sheraton Sand Key Resort. Fares begin at **\$8 for single riders**, \$20 for a group of four, and \$30 for groups of five to eight. The airport also has taxis, Lyft and Uber. The approximate **taxi** fare from St. Pete-Clearwater International Airport to the Sheraton Sand Key Resort in Clearwater Beach is around **\$30 to \$40** one way. The approximate **ride-share fare** typically ranges from **\$25 to \$35** one way.

Way2Go Rides offers private airport shuttles for **\$59.50** for up to 6 people. Book in advance online at way2gorides.com (recommended) or call 727-424-5458. Save \$10 per ride when booking with code **SKAL**.

The Sheraton Sand Key Resort is a 17-mile drive from PIE (depending on time of day/traffic) and also takes about 30 - 45 minutes.

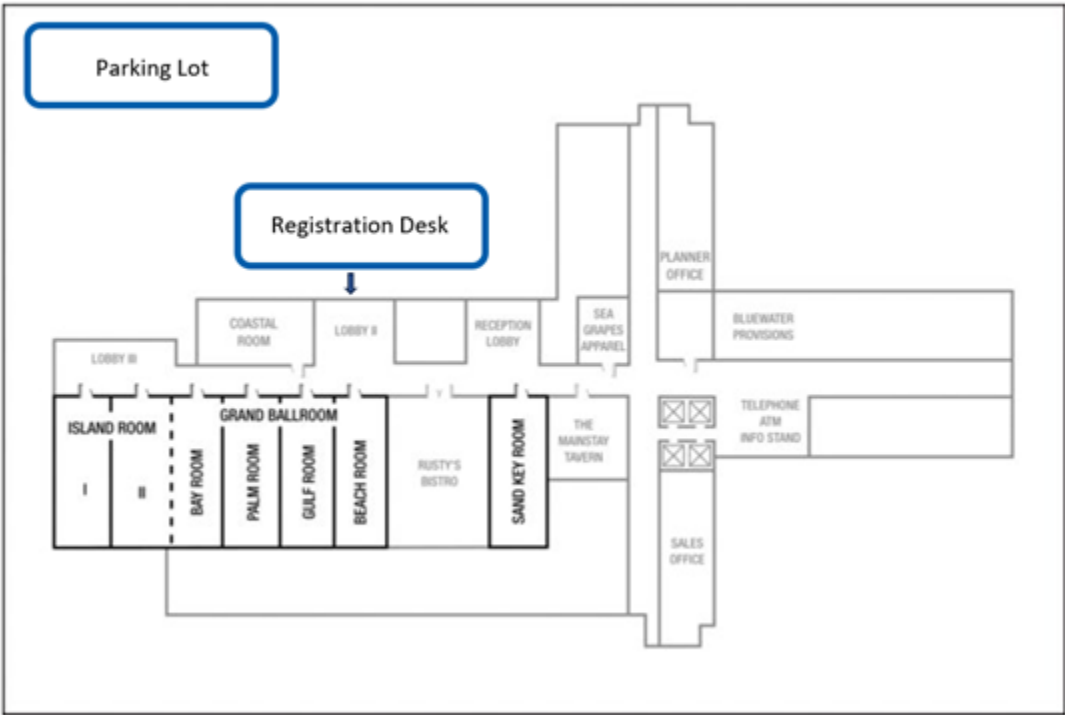

Expected Weather

Historically the first week of May in Clearwater typically brings warm and pleasant weather, as the area transitions from spring to the beginning of the hot summer months. Here's a breakdown of the average weather conditions:

Temperature: The average high temperature during the day is around 85°F (29°C), while the low temperature at night is about 70°F (21°C).

Humidity: May marks the start of the wet season in Florida, so humidity levels can be quite high, generally ranging from 60% to 80%, making it feel warmer than the actual temperature.

Rainfall: There is a moderate chance of rain, with occasional afternoon thunderstorms becoming more common. On average, Clearwater sees about 2–3 inches of rain during the month of May.

Sunshine: Expect plenty of sunshine, though with some cloud cover and possible rain showers in the afternoon. Clear skies are frequent, and the region enjoys about 9-10 hours of daylight.

Welcome to Tampa Bay – A Brief History!

The Tampa Bay area is a vibrant destination where history, culture, and modern innovation seamlessly blend together. Located on Florida's Gulf Coast, the Tampa Bay region is known for its warm weather, beautiful waterfront views, and bustling urban life. Whether you're here for a conference or just to take in the sights, the area offers something for everyone—from world-class dining to fascinating museums and outdoor adventures. But beyond its contemporary charm, Tampa Bay has a deep history that shapes its unique character.

The downtown area boasts a blend of modern architecture and historic buildings, including the restored Tampa Theatre and the iconic Sunshine Skyway Bridge. Ybor City remains a must-see, offering a taste of the past with its cobblestone streets and lively atmosphere, while nearby districts like the Riverwalk provide a picturesque view of the bay, perfect for a stroll or a boat tour. As the area has evolved, it has maintained its historical roots while becoming a hub for business, technology, and culture.

The nearby city of St. Petersburg, located just across the bay, offers its own unique history and charm. Originally founded as a resort town, it has transformed into a thriving arts and cultural district with a rich collection of museums, galleries, and entertainment.
